

# REPORT FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN

## **Case overview**

1. The Department (DIAC) states that on 26 March 2010 Mr X was removed to Vietnam.
2. DIAC advises that Mr X received three weeks accommodation and a destitute allowance, and was advised of post-arrival support available to him in Vietnam.

## **Ombudsman consideration**

3. DIAC's further report to the Ombudsman under s 486N of the *Migration Act 1958* is dated 26 March 2010.
4. Ombudsman staff sighted a medical summary report from International Health and Medical Services (IHMS) dated 8 March 2010.

## **Key issues**

### *Health and welfare*

5. The IHMS report states that Mr X '*chose to cease all medications on 12/1/2010*'. Mr X received a mental state examination in December 2009, where '*no mental health issues were identified*'.

## **Ombudsman assessment/recommendation**

6. The Ombudsman notes that Mr X was removed to Vietnam on 26 March 2010 and makes no recommendations in this report.
