# Recent visa applications/case progression

23 October 2015	Master Y was notified that he is eligible to receive the Primary Application Information Service to assist him with lodging a temporary visa application. On 4 November 2015 he accepted the offer.
7 April 2016	Mr X and his brother lodged a Safe Haven Enterprise visa (SHEV) application.

#### Health and welfare

Mr X and his brother did not require treatment for any major physical or mental health issues.

## Case status

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 19 April 2016 and released from immigration detention. His brother Master Y remains in community detention.

On 7 April 2016 Mr X and his brother lodged a SHEV application.
