27 March 2013	Granted a Bridging visa valid to 27 September 2013 and released from Curtin Immigration Detention Centre (IDC).
18 February 2014	Located and re-detained under s 189(1) after living unlawfully in the community.
11 September 2015	Granted a Bridging visa and released from Wickham Point Alternative Place of Detention.

Visa applications/case progression

The Minister lifted the bar under s 46A to allow Mr X to lodge a
temporary visa application. The Department of Immigration and Border
Protection invited him to apply on 31 August 2015.

Health and welfare

Mr X was provided with treatment for a range of physical health issues including back pain. He was also provided with treatment and counselling for a range of mental health issues including a history of torture and trauma and anxiety.

Case status

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 11 September 2015 and released from immigration detention.
