

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND

This is the second s 486O report on Mr X and his son, Mr Y, who remained in immigration detention for more than 42 months (three and a half years).

The first report 1003308 was tabled in Parliament on 14 September 2016. This report updates the material in that report and should be read in conjunction with the previous report.

24 March 2016	Mr Y was notified that he and his father were eligible to receive the Primary Application Information Service to assist them with lodging a new temporary visa application or providing supporting information for their existing application. He accepted the offer on 5 April 2016 and was assigned a provider.
17 March 2017	Granted SHEVs.

**Health and welfare**

Mr X and his son were provided with treatment for physical health issues including chest pain and latent tuberculosis. Mr X also attended psychological counselling for management of mental health concerns, including a history of torture and trauma.
