

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND

29 September 2015	The Minister lifted the bar under s 46A of the <i>Migration Act 1958</i> to allow Master X to lodge a temporary visa application.
14 December 2015	Master X lodged a Safe Haven Enterprise visa application with the assistance of his Primary Application Information Service provider.
