

**ASSESSMENT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH OMBUDSMAN
FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT**

Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958

This is the third s 486O assessment on Mr X, Ms Y and their two children who remained in immigration detention for more than 48 months (four years).

The first assessment 1002062 was tabled in Parliament on 11 November 2015 and the second assessment 1001181-O was tabled in Parliament on 15 February 2017. This assessment provides an update and should be read in conjunction with the previous assessments.

The children did not require treatment for any major physical or mental health issues during this assessment period.
