22 October 2015	Mr X accepted DIBP's offer of the Primary Application Information Service.

Mr X was provided with treatment for previously diagnosed physical health issues including bladder and bowel issues, complications from cancer treatment and chronic pain. He was also provided with counselling for ongoing treatment and surgeries relating to his physical health issues.
