

## **ASSESSMENT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT**

*Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958*

This is the third s 486O assessment on Mr X who remained in immigration detention for more than 48 months (four years).

The first assessment 1001892 was tabled in Parliament on 4 March 2015 and the second assessment 1003428 was tabled in Parliament on 31 August 2016. This assessment provides an update and should be read in conjunction with the previous assessments.

### **Recent visa applications/case progression**

31 March 2016	Mr X was notified that he is eligible to receive the Primary Application Information Service to assist him with lodging a new temporary visa application or providing supporting information for his existing application. He accepted the offer on 8 April 2016 and was assigned a provider.
22 February 2017	Granted a Bridging visa.
