

**REPORT FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT BY
THE COMMONWEALTH AND IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN**

Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958

This is the third s 486O report on Mr X who was previously known as Mr Y. The first report 623/11 was tabled in Parliament on 11 May 2011 and the second report 747/12 was tabled in Parliament on 20 June 2012. This report updates the material in those reports and should be read in conjunction with the previous reports.

Detention history

2 December 2008	First arrived in Australia aboard Suspected Illegal Entry Vessel 28 <i>Wasat</i> .
7 December 2008	Detained under s 189(3) of the <i>Migration Act 1958</i> and transferred to North West Point Immigration Detention Centre (IDC), Christmas Island.
12 August 2009	Transferred to Melbourne Immigration Transit Accommodation.
1 September 2009	Transferred to community detention.

Recent visa application process

22 November 2011	Lodged a further submission with the Minister for consideration under s 195A of the <i>Migration Act</i> .
24 March 2012	The Minister declined to intervene in Mr X's case.
24 August 2012	Lodged a further submission with the Minister for consideration under s 195A. Due to issues with establishing Mr X's identity, the submission was not referred to the Minister.
14 November 2012	National and Identity Assessment finalised. Detention Review and Complex Complaints Section recommended that Mr X be re-referred to the Minister now that his identity has been established.
19 November 2012	Generalised Violence Assessment for country A found it is reasonable for Mr X to return to the country.

Health and welfare

May 2012	Despite taking antidepressant medication, a psychologist report indicated that Mr X appeared anxious, thought-disordered and of low mood.
9 July 2012	Attended appointment for an X-ray of the right foot after an injury. Results showed no abnormalities.

Case status

Mr X has no matters before the Department of Immigration and Citizenship or the courts and has been re-referred for consideration of a Bridging visa pending removal action.
