

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND  
IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT**

*Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958*

This is the second s 486O report on Mr X who remained in restricted immigration detention for more than 30 months (two and a half years).

**Recent visa applications/case progression**

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) advised that prior to ministerial intervention, Mr X was part of a cohort who had not had their protection claims assessed as they arrived in Australia after 13 August 2012 and were subject to the bar under s 46A of the *Migration Act 1958*.

6 November 2015	Mr X was invited to lodge a temporary visa application.

**Health and welfare**

Mr X was provided with treatment for physical health issues including shoulder, rib and back pain. No significant mental health issues were raised during this reporting period.

**Case status**

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 9 June 2016 and released from immigration detention.
