

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND
IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT**

Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958

This is the fourth s 486O report on Mr X and his family who remained in immigration detention for more than 60 months (five years).

The first report 1587/13 was tabled in Parliament on 4 December 2013, the second report 1001203 was tabled in Parliament on 25 June 2014 and the third report 1001842 was tabled in Parliament on 17 June 2015. This report updates the material in those reports and should be read in conjunction with the previous reports.
