## **Detention history**

14 November 2012	Detained under s 189(3) of the <i>Migration Act 1958</i> after arriving in Australia aboard Suspected Illegal Entry Vessel 534 <i>Mustang</i> .
15 May 2013	Granted a Bridging visa and released from Curtin Immigration Detention Centre (IDC).
6 July 2014	Located and arrested by New South Wales Police. He was subsequently re-detained under s 189(1) and transferred to Villawood IDC.
3 February 2016	Granted a Bridging visa and released from restricted detention.

## Visa applications/case progression

8 July 2014	Mr X was charged with assaulting police. He was convicted and entered into a good behaviour bond on 17 December 2014.
17 September 2015	Lodged a Temporary Protection visa application.

### Health and welfare

Mr X was provided with treatment and counselling for a range of mental health issues including a history of torture and trauma.

### **Case status**

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 3 February 2016 and released from immigration detention.
