

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND
IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT**

Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958

This is the third s 486O report on Mr X who remained in restricted immigration detention for more than 42 months (three and a half years).

The first report 1001692 was tabled in Parliament on 29 October 2014 and the second report 1002170 was tabled in Parliament on 3 February 2016. This report updates the material in those reports and should be read in conjunction with the previous reports.
