

## REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT

*Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958*

This is the third s 486O report on Mr X and his family who remained in immigration detention for more than 36 months (three years).

The first report 1001622 was tabled in Parliament on 29 October 2014 and the second report 1002112 was tabled in Parliament on 3 June 2015. This report updates the material in those reports and should be read in conjunction with the previous reports.

### Recent detention history

22 December 2014	Mr X was transferred from Yongah Hill Immigration Detention Centre to join his wife, Ms Y, and their three daughters in community detention.
15 October 2015	Mr X and his family were granted Temporary Protection visas. Mr X and Ms Y and two of their daughters were released from community detention.

### Recent visa applications/case progression

18 June 2015	Mr X's daughter, Ms Z, was granted a Bridging visa and released from detention following her engagement to an Australian citizen.
15 October 2015	Mr X and his family were granted Temporary Protection visas.

### Health and welfare

The family was provided with treatment and counselling for a range of physical and mental health issues including depression and anxiety.

### Case status

Mr X and his family, including Ms Z, were granted Temporary Protection visas on 15 October 2015 and released from immigration detention.
