Recent visa applications/case progression

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) advised that Mr X's request for ministerial intervention remained ongoing pending the outcome of an International Treaties Obligations Assessment (ITOA).	
10 February 2015	Mr X withdrew his application for judicial review.
16 March 2015	He attended an ITOA interview.

Health and welfare

Mr X was provided with treatment and counselling for a range of mental health issues including depression and anxiety.

Case status

Mr X has been found not to be owed protection under the Refugee Convention and the complementary protection criterion. At the time of DIBP's review, he was awaiting the outcome of an ITOA.
Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 26 November 2015 and released from immigration detention.
