

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND
IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT**

Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958

This is the third s 486O report on Mr X who remained in restricted immigration detention for more than 42 months (three and a half years).

The first report 1001714 was tabled in Parliament on 22 October 2014 and the second report 1002185 was tabled in Parliament on 3 February 2016. This report updates the material in those reports and should be read in conjunction with the previous reports.

Recent visa applications/case progression

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) advised that Mr X was awaiting the outcome of judicial review by the Federal Circuit Court in relation to the Refugee Review Tribunal's decision to affirm DIBP's refusal of his Temporary Protection visa application.

Health and welfare

Mr X was provided with treatment for a range of physical issues including a leg deformity.

Case status

Mr X has been found not to be owed protection under the Refugee Convention and the complementary protection criterion. He is awaiting the outcome of judicial review.

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 23 May 2016 and released from immigration detention.
