

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND
IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT**

Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958

This is the third s 486O report on Mr X who remained in restricted immigration detention for more than 42 months (three and a half years).

The first report 1001481 was tabled in Parliament on 22 October 2014 and the second report 1001904 was tabled in Parliament on 9 September 2015. This report updates the material in those reports and should be read in conjunction with the previous reports.

November 2015	Mr X was released from Christmas Island Immigration Detention Centre when he voluntarily departed Australia and returned to Country A.

Recent visa applications/case progression

23 April 2015	Mr X's case was found not to meet the guidelines for referral to the Minister under s 48B of the <i>Migration Act 1958</i> to allow him to submit a valid visa application.
24 September 2015	Mr X was awaiting a hearing by the Federal Circuit Court in relation to the Department of Immigration and Border Protection's decision about an International Treaties Obligations Assessment.

Health and welfare

Mr X was provided with treatment for a range of mental health issues including anger and poor impulse control. He was also referred for counselling for substance abuse issues but declined to attend scheduled appointments.

Case status

Mr X voluntarily departed Australia in November 2015 and returned to Country A.
