

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND

Recent visa applications/case progression

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) advised that prior to ministerial intervention, Mr X was part of a cohort who had not had their protection claims assessed as they arrived in Australia after 13 August 2012 and were subject to the bar under s 46A of the *Migration Act 1958*.

16 November 2015	Mr X was invited to lodge a temporary visa application.
4 April 2016	Mr X accepted DIBP's offer of the Primary Application Information Service.

Health and welfare

Mr X did not require treatment for any major physical or mental health issues.

Case status

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 19 April 2016 and released from immigration detention.
