

ASSESSMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT

Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958

This is the third s 486O assessment on Mr X who remained in immigration detention for more than 42 months (three and a half years). The previous assessment 1001955-O was tabled in Parliament on 15 February 2017. This assessment provides an update and should be read in conjunction with the previous assessments.

Recent detention history

Mr X continued to be placed in the community.	
30 May 2017	Granted a bridging visa and released from immigration detention.

14 September 2016	Safe Haven Enterprise visa (SHEV) application refused.
20 September 2016	Mr X's case was referred to the Immigration Assessment Authority (IAA) for review.
18 January 2017	The IAA affirmed the decision to refuse Mr X's SHEV application.

Mr X was provided with treatment for physical health issues including ongoing back pain.
