# RESPONSE TO OMBUDSMAN'S ASSESSMENT NO. 4 / 2019 MADE UNDER SECTION 4860 OF THE MIGRATION ACT 1958

I note the Ombudsman's recommendation. This person's case has been referred for my consideration under section 195A of *Migration Act 1958* (the Act) for the grant of a Bridging E visa.

## 2. Tabling statement for case: 1002719-O1.

I note the Ombudsman's recommendations. This person was recently granted a Safe Haven Enterprise (subclass 790) visa and is living lawfully in the community.
