26 July 2016	Mr X's case was referred on a first stage submission for the Minister's indication on whether he would be inclined to consider intervening under s 195A of the <i>Migration Act 1958</i> to grant a Bridging visa.
13 September 2016	The Minister agreed to consider Mr X's case on a second stage submission
11 October 2016	DIBP advised Mr X's SHEV interview was scheduled for 29 October 2016.

Criminal history

On 13 January 2016 Mr X entered a plea of not guilty in relation to charges of riot arising from the disturbance on Christmas Island on 5 September 2014. He attended ten-day trial commencing on 2 May 2016. He pleaded guilty to a charge of taking part in an unlawful assembly and was sentenced to a conditional release order to be of good behaviour for six months. Mr X applied for, and was granted a spent conviction.

Health and welfare

Mr X was provided with treatment for chronic lower-back and neck pain.

Case status

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 19 October 2016 and released from immigration detention.
