

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND

This is the fourth s 486O report on Mr X who remained in immigration detention for more than 60 months (five years).

The first report 1001142 was tabled in Parliament on 28 May 2014, the second report 1001733 was tabled in Parliament on 18 March 2015 and the third report 1002211 was tabled in Parliament on 31 August 2016. This report updates the material in those reports and should be read in conjunction with the previous reports.
