

ASSESSMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT

Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958

This is the sixth s 486O assessment on Mr X who remained in immigration detention for more than 84 months (seven years). The previous assessment 1000142-O was tabled in Parliament on 10 May 2017. This assessment provides an update and should be read in conjunction with the previous assessments.

<p>Mr X was granted a bridging visa on 18 July 2017 and was released from immigration detention.</p> <p>The Ombudsman's previous assessment noted that Mr X had continued to await the resolution of a security assessment for an extended period and recommended that the Minister enquire about the status of Mr X's security assessment.</p> <p>On 10 May 2017 the Minister advised that Mr X's security assessment had been finalised.</p>
