

REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT

Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958

This is the fourth s 486O report on Mr X who remained in restricted immigration detention for more than 42 months (three and a half years).

The first report 1002165 was tabled in Parliament on 27 May 2015 and the second report 1002418 was tabled in Parliament on 14 September 2015 and the third report 1003487 was tabled in Parliament on 31 August 2016. This report updates the material in those reports and should be read in conjunction with the previous reports.
