# REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN TO THE MINISTER FOR IMMIGRATION AND BORDER PROTECTION

This is the fourth s 4860 report on Mr X who remained in immigration detention for a cumulative period of more than 66 months (five and a half years).

The first report 1316/13 was tabled in Parliament on 26 June 2013, the second report 1001342 was tabled in Parliament on 22 October 2014 and the third report 1002035 was tabled in Parliament on 3 June 2015. This report updates the material in those reports and should be read in conjunction with the previous reports.

## Recent visa applications/case progression

4 March 2016	The Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) finalised an International Treaties Obligations Assessment and found that Mr X's case engaged Australia's non-refoulement obligations.
21 March 2016	Mr X was invited to apply for a temporary visa.

### Health and welfare

Mr X was provided with treatment for a range of physical health issues including asthma. He was also provided with treatment and counselling for a range of mental health issues including major depression with psychotic features, atypical psychosis, an adjustment disorder and post-traumatic stress disorder.

DIBP advised that Mr X had a significant history of suicide attempts and self-harm.

### Case status

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 9 June 2016 and released from immigration detention.
