

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND

This is the second s 486O report on Mr X who remained in restricted immigration detention for more than 36 months (three years).

19 October 2016	Granted a Bridging visa and released from restricted detention.

15 August 2016	The Department of Immigration and Border Protection advised that Mr X continues to await the finalisation of his Safe Haven Enterprise visa application.

**Health and welfare**

Mr X was provided with treatment for physical health issues. He also received treatment and counselling for a range of mental health issues including a history of torture and trauma and depression.	
The department advised that Mr X had a history of suicide attempts and self-harm.	
16 February 2016 and 19 April 2016	Incident Reports recorded that Mr X self-harmed and required emergency hospital treatment on two occasions.

**Case status**

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 19 October 2016 and was released from immigration detention.
