

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND  
IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT**

This is the first s 486O report on Mr X who remained in restricted immigration detention for a cumulative period of more than 30 months (two and a half years).

**Detention history**

11 September 2012	Detained under s 189(3) of the <i>Migration Act 1958</i> after arriving in Australia aboard Suspected Illegal Entry Vessel 446 <i>Aaron</i> .
14 February 2013	Granted a Bridging visa and released from Scherger Immigration Detention Centre (IDC).
12 September 2013	Re-detained under s 189(1) following assault charges and transferred to Maribyrnong IDC.
5 May 2016	Granted a Bridging visa and released from restricted detention.

**Visa applications/case progression**

23 September 2015	Mr X lodged a Safe Haven Enterprise visa application.

Mr X was provided with treatment for shoulder pain and a knee injury. He was also provided with treatment and counselling for a range of mental health issues including a history of torture and trauma.
