

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND  
IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT**

This is the second s 486O report on Mr X who remained in restricted immigration detention for more than 36 months (three years).

19 October 2016	Granted a Bridging visa and released from restricted detention.

**Recent visa applications/case progression**

22 February 2016	Mr X was notified he was eligible to receive the Primary Application Information Service to assist him with lodging a temporary visa application. He accepted the offer on 29 February 2016 and was assigned a provider.
9 May 2016	Mr X lodged a Safe Haven Enterprise visa application.

**Health and welfare**

Mr X was provided with treatment for physical health issues including hepatitis C and human immunodeficiency virus. He also received treatment and counselling for a range of mental health issues including a history of torture and trauma and an adjustment disorder.

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 19 October 2016 and was released from immigration detention.
