

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND  
IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT**

*Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958*

This is the second s 486O report on Mr X who remained in restricted immigration detention for more than 42 months (three and a half years).

The first report 1002455 was tabled in Parliament on 8 November 2016. This report updates the material in that report and should be read in conjunction with the previous report.

**Recent visa applications/case progression**

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection (the department) advised that Mr X has been found not to be owed protection under the Refugee Convention and complementary protection criterion.

At the time of the department's review Mr X was awaiting the outcome of judicial review by the Federal Circuit Court of the Refugee Review Tribunal's decision to affirm the refusal of his Protection visa application.

**Health and welfare**

Mr X did not require treatment for any major physical or mental health issues.

**Case status**

Mr X has been found not to be owed protection under the Refugee Convention and the complementary protection criterion. At the time of the department's review Mr X was awaiting the outcome of judicial review.

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 30 November 2016 and was released from immigration detention.
