

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND

Mr X was provided with treatment and counselling for a range of mental health issues including a history of torture and trauma, post-traumatic stress disorder and anxiety.

Case status

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 3 March 2016 and released from immigration detention.
