## RESPONSE TO OMBUDSMAN'S ASSESSMENTS MADE UNDER SECTION 4860 OF THE MIGRATION ACT 1958

### STATEMENT TO PARLIAMENT - No. 19 / 2016

### General Comments

I refer to the Commonwealth Ombudsman's assessments tabled in Parliament today. The 50 assessments refer to 121 people who have been in immigration detention for two or more years. Of these, 25 assessments pertaining to 81 detainees contained recommendations.

Response to the Commonwealth Ombudsman's assessments

## 1. Tabling statement for assessments: 1002512, 1002744, 1002771, 1003124

I note the Ombudsman's recommendations. I have intervened under section 46A of the *Migration Act 1958* (the Act) to lift the bar to allow these people to lodge a Temporary Protection visa or a Safe Haven Enterprise visa application. These people have been granted Bridging E visas and are currently residing lawfully in the community.

## 2. <u>Tabling statement for assessments: 1002063, 1002217, 1002385, 1002694, 1002782, 1002888, 1002896, 1002996, 1003013, 1003076</u>

I note the Ombudsman's recommendations. I have intervened under section 46A of the Act to lift the bar to allow these people to lodge a Temporary Protection visa or a Safe Haven Enterprise visa application. These people have been invited to apply for a Temporary Protection visa or a Safe Haven Enterprise visa. These people have been granted Bridging E visas and are currently residing lawfully in the community.

# 5. <u>Tabling statement for assessments: 1002071, 1002377, 1002789, 1002825, 1002887, 1002890, 1002898, 1002902, 1002949, 1002964</u>

I note the Ombudsman's recommendations. I have intervened under section 46A of the Act to lift the bar to allow these people to lodge a Temporary Protection visa or a Safe Haven Enterprise visa application. These people have lodged an application for a Temporary Protection visa or a Safe Haven Enterprise visa. These people have been granted Bridging E visas and are currently residing lawfully in the community.

### 6. Tabling statement for assessment: 1002487

I note the Ombudsman's recommendation. I have intervened under section 46A of the Act to lift the bar to allow these people to lodge a Temporary Protection visa or a Safe Haven Enterprise visa application. These people lodged an application for a Temporary Protection visa or a Safe Haven Enterprise visa. The department refused the application. This case has been referred to the Immigration Assessment Authority for review of the decision. These people have been granted Bridging E visas and are currently residing lawfully in the community.
