

**REPORT (ABRIDGED) BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND
IMMIGRATION OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT**

This is the third s 486O report on Mr X who remained in immigration detention for more than 42 months (three and a half years).

The first report 1002947 was tabled in Parliament on 14 October 2015 and the second report 1003148 was tabled in Parliament on 20 October 2016. This report updates the material in those reports and should be read in conjunction with the previous reports.¹
