

ASSESSMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OMBUDSMAN FOR TABLING IN PARLIAMENT

Under s 486O of the Migration Act 1958

This is the fourth s 486O assessment on Mr X who remained in immigration detention for more than 54 months (four and a half years). The previous assessment 1001659-O1 was tabled in Parliament on 13 September 2017. This assessment provides an update and should be read in conjunction with the previous assessments.

Recent detention history

Since the Ombudsman's previous assessment, Mr X remained at Facility B.	
February 2018	Voluntarily departed Australia.

Recent visa applications/case progression

7 August 2017	Requested removal from Australia.
26 September 2017	The Department of Home Affairs advised that Mr X's application for a travel document lodged with the authorities of Country A continued to be processed.

Health and welfare

International Health and Medical Services advised that Mr X continued to receive treatment for multiple physical health conditions, including type 2 diabetes, shoulder and knee pain, osteoarthritis, and an eye concern.

Case status

Mr X was detained on 28 March 2013 after arriving in Australia by sea and remained in an immigration detention facility for more than four and a half years. Mr X was released from immigration detention when he voluntarily departed Australia in February 2018.
