Recent visa applications/case progression

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection (the department) advised that Mr X has been found not to be owed protection under the Refugee Convention and complementary protection criterion. He was awaiting the outcome of judicial review of the department's refusal of his Protection visa application.

Health and welfare

Mr X was provided with treatment for physical health issues. He also received treatment and counselling for a range of mental health issues including a history of torture and trauma and an adjustment disorder.

Case status

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 18 October 2016 and was released from immigration detention.
