# Health and welfare

Mr X was provided with treatment for physical health issues including chronic sciatica and treatment and counselling for a range of mental health issues including a history of torture and trauma, an adjustment disorder, depressive symptoms and detention fatigue.

#### Other matters

During an interview with Ombudsman staff on 24 March 2016 Mr X advised that his mental health had been affected by his prolonged detention. He said he found the atmosphere at the detention centre to be very aggressive and he was fearful of having his belongings stolen by other detainees.

### **Case status**

Mr X was granted a Temporary Protection visa on 2 September 2016 and released from immigration detention.
