## **Detention history**

11 July 2012	Detained under s 189(3) of the <i>Migration Act 1958</i> after arriving in Australia aboard Suspected Illegal Entry Vessel 2012-4553 <i>Zeerust</i> .
25 October 2012	Granted a Bridging visa and released from restricted detention.
18 December 2014	Re-detained under s 189(1) after failing to depart Australia.
21 September 2016	Granted a Bridging visa and released from restricted detention.

## Visa applications/case progression

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection (the department) advised that Mr X has been found not to be owed protection under the Refugee Convention and complementary protection criterion. He has no outstanding matters before the department, courts or tribunals and is on a removal pathway.

#### Health and welfare

Mr X was provided with treatment for physical health issues. He also received treatment and counselling for detention fatigue.

#### Case status

Mr X was granted a Bridging visa on 21 September 2016 and was released from immigration detention.
